Dear Ms. Mass:

Thank you for submitting the proposed transfer of The Hanover Insurance Company (Hanover) liabilities within the Excess and Casualty Reinsurance Association to National Legacy Insurance Company (NLIC). The transfer of the above-mentioned business from Hanover to NLIC will be carried out under the Insurance Business Act (the IBT Act) enacted by the Oklahoma Legislature effective November 1, 2018 and amended in April 2022. The IBT Act enables a book of policies to be completely separated from one insurer and moved to another using an Insurance Business Plan, which must be approved by the District Court of Cleveland County, Oklahoma, following a review of the transaction by an Independent Expert and the Oklahoma Insurance Department.

Please be advised that the New Hampshire Insurance Department does not object to the proposed transaction. Please notify us of any changes to the draft documents.
